Candidates are required to pass the UMU **Graduate Admission Test (GAT)** and have at least two years of working experience in the relevant field.

Early applications are advisable. Please apply before 19th May 2017

The third **Graduate Admission Test (GAT)** will be administered on 27th May 2017. Please note that the **Graduate Admission Test (GAT)** will be conducted by invitation.
