Graduates of the Faculty should have also mastered and internalised certain ethical values which will add an extra dimension to the skills they bring to professional position.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE for B.B.A.M.

In order to train an all-rounder, both managerially and behaviourally, the Faculty focuses on three areas: finance/accounting, management/marketing and Procurement.

These three subject areas are interlinked in order to ensure the formation of graduates who are management, procurement as well as business policy-oriented practitioners. Differentiation between subject majors is kept at a minimum and only in the third year are students able to do specialisation in one of the three subject areas.
